ARTS & CRAFT VENDOR AGREEMENT

This Arts & Crafts Agreement is between the Eastern Shoshone Entertainment Committee and **Vendor Name: (Please Print Legible):**_____.

Arts & Craft Vendor Space Fee must be paid in full to the Vendor Committee by **June 1, 2023**. **No Exceptions.** There will be no solicitations for sale of merchandise of any type without full payment or Vendor committee consent and/or knowledge.

1. Vendors are responsible to provide documentation of Tribal Enrollment or Census number prior to acceptance of application by the Vendor Committee.
2. There are approximately 30(10x10) booth space, first come first serve, available for Arts & Crafts; **Directly behind certain booths is either for vehicle or camping, not both, there is camping around the grounds.** Most booth will be allowed on electric outlet, to be used for booth lighting only. Electrical outlet is **not to be used for RV's, Air Conditioners, etc.**
3. **No payment arrangements will be made; BOOTHS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE A NUMBER IS ASSIGNED.**
4. There is NO RV hookups, no power for polishing machine, small appliances, etc...There are camping spots available on the grounds for free of charge, may use own generator
5. **Limited Power is available, and you must furnish your own 110 amp extension cords.** United Laboratory (UL) rating must be on all electric cords and surge protectors (if used), to avoid any electrical fires. Booths will use electricity wisely and not over load circuits. Generators are recommended in case of power failure.
6. Daily inspections will take place during the powwow by the Fire District & Entertainment Committee, if a vendor is in non-compliance:
 - Verbal warning given
 - Written warning given and a fine of \$100.00
 - Escorted off the powwow grounds and possible prosecuted in Tribal courts
7. Vendor cannot allow another vendor (part/individual) to set up in their booths unless (party/individual) is listed on application and signed agreement.
8. REFUND, there will be absolutely no refunds due to natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise throughout the powwow.
9. **Depending upon Availability;** *if an application is received after June 1,2023, there will be a late charge of \$50.00.*
10. **Vendors must maintain a clean environment in and around booth area!** Vendors are responsible of disposing of their own garbage.

11. Vendors will be issued only 1 vehicle pass upon arrival if in restricted areas. **ABSOLUTELY NO driving in/out of the arbor/vendor area after 5:00 PM – 11:00 pm, beginning Thursday June 22nd – Sunday, June 25th, 2022, park out in the designated parking area.**
12. Beaded items for sale must be *Authentic Native American Indian* made, **NO IMITATIONS.**
13. No selling of Food (consumable items or drinks) at Arts & Craft vendor booths or camp ground area.
14. No selling on festival grounds of pirated or unauthorized filming of powwows, on DVD's & CD's!
15. Consumption of any alcoholic beverages or use of illegal drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED! It is the Vendors responsibility to enforce this policy among his/her employees and associates. Vendors are who are intoxicated or in possession of alcohol/drugs shall be turned over to local law enforcement and removed from the grounds.

Vendors violating any of the conditions shall be immediately subject to cancellation of the agreement and will be escorted from the premises by local law enforcement, merchandise items will be confiscated and possible prosecuted in tribal courts.

I understand that this application does not guarantee any liability from the Eastern Shoshone Entertainment Committee or The Eastern Shoshone Tribe for natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise or for accidents, fires, theft or any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Eastern Shoshone Entertainment Committee or The Eastern Shoshone Tribe.

I have read and fully understand the terms of this Arts & Craft Vendor Agreement and agree to comply with all the provisions stated.
